Works Selected for In SITE Out 2007

In SITE Out, Orange Botanical Gardens, 26 October - 18 November

From sculptures to potato portraits, workshops for kids to silky banners, the selection panel charged with assessing expressions of interest for **In SITE Out 2007, the temporary & ephemeral art event at Orange Botanic Gardens**, were delighted with the quality and diversity of proposals received.

A wide range of local, interstate and international artists both professional and emerging artists including TAFE and CSU students submitted sculptural and workshop proposals of which 30 projects have been selected.

Artists have just under four months to develop their work, ready for the event which will run from **October 26 to November 18** throughout the Orange Botanic Gardens.

But it's not just innovative artworks that will make up this third biennial event. One of the selected proposals is a set of children's drama/physical theatre workshops set within one of the outdoor spaces of the Gardens. The workshop will include the making of an installation element as a welcoming arbour archway.

You can still be involved: Arts OutWest is now inviting schools, performance and community groups from across the Central West to express an interest in participating. The organisers are looking for performances and activities that respond to the natural settings of the gardens.

In SITE Out will be the final event of **Orange Wine Week**, with Taste and Waste art-making workshops and displays, local food and wine in and around the Clover Hill Function Centre.

The program will include a weekend Arts Conference and end with an Artists Market as part the Colour City Garden Weekend.
