### Free funding and grant writing workshop in Trundle

Arts OutWest will hold a free funding and grant writing workshop in Trundle on Friday May 9.

The workshop is a general introduction to grant writing with a focus on funding for arts and cultural activities including festivals and events, development and infrastructure projects. Examples of successful funding applications and valuable resources will be made available. Participants will also have an opportunity to tackle an application and receive feedback.
