

Arts OutWest Mentorships

Background

Arts OutWest's professional development strand for 2010 includes the opportunity for three Central West people involved in the arts to be mentored by an expert in their field. Whether you are a community volunteer needing more guidance on how to deliver projects more effectively, or a professional wanting assistance in moving your arts business up a level, these mentorships are an opportunity to develop your skills, your connections and your practice.

The program will involve:

1. An introductory session with Arts OutWest on how to make the most of the mentoring program. The session will also look at arts networks.
2. Brokering by Arts OutWest to match you with a mentor that you would like to work with.
3. Time with your mentor (usually 2 days, either as block time or divided up into short sessions).

Mentor travel and some travel costs will be covered by Arts OutWest. This program has been made possible through funding by Arts Training NSW. There is no cost to the participants being mentored.
